RESOLUTION: 2019-15 Approval of Electing the Streamlined Conversion to Section 8

Whereas, the Board of the Newton Housing Authority have previously applied for and received approval to convert to the HUD rental housing demonstration grant program, and;

Whereas, HUD issued PIH Notice 2019-05 titled streamlined voluntary conversion of last remaining projects of small public housing agencies, and;

Whereas, Newton is eligible to convert to the Housing Choice Voucher Program as allowed by Notice 2019-05, and;

Whereas, the election to convert under this Notice is contingent on entering into a shared service agreement for housing choice voucher program administration and action to withdraw from the rental housing demonstration grant assistance award.

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Commissioners of the Newton Housing Authority electing to apply for the conversion to Section 8 and to withdraw from the rental assistance demonstration grant program and authorize the Interim Executive Director to take whatever actions are necessary.
