REQUEST FOR BIDS

The Newton Housing Authority, 32 Liberty Street, Newton, New Jersey will accept proposals for the completion of an Infrared Thermographic Survey of the roof at Liberty Towers. It is the Housing Authority's desire to retain and employ a duly qualified and capable contractor. All services must be in accordance with the existing laws, rules, orders, directives, and regulations governing these services.

The services that are requested will be as follows:

- Perform a visual inspection of the roof with the owner to become familiar with the roof's history and inspect the roof prior to the scan.
- Extract a core sample from the existing roof and document roof components and effective R-Values. Fill all test cuts according to the manufacturer's requirements and procedures and per NRCA.
- 3) Perform an infrared thermographic survey of all roofs to detect areas of subsurface moisture. The study should be performed at night to obtain high quality information and data.
- Take core samples and/or moisture probes of the roof to verify the presence of water.
- 5) Outline the affected areas on the roof membrane with longlasting spray paint.
- 6) Prepare sealed AutoCAD drawings (blueprints) of the roof(s) with the water damaged areas plotted on them.
- 7) Prepare and submit a final report documenting the survey

techniques and findings. The report should be provided in paper and digital format and will include weather conditions, thermographic testing principles, roof construction details, survey procedures, AutoCAD Drawings (4 copies-24"x36" masters and 2 copies-11"x17" field copies), summary of findings (include total sq. ft of roof number of wet areas detected and total sq. ft of wet areas and percentage of wet areas.

8) The building is available for inspection Monday to Friday (11:00 AM to 2:00 PM).

Qualifications:

1) Should be in the thermographic infrared survey business a minimum of three years.

2) Must be approvable by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide these services.

Bid Submission:

All persons interested in submitting a proposal for the Housing Authority's Infrared Thermographer Report should submit a price based upon a lump sum.

The proposal must include the following:

- 1) Proposal Form
- 2) An itemization of other expenses (if any).
- 3) Copy of the vendor's insurance certificate.
- 4) Listing of references and current customers.

Proposals should be delivered to the Newton Housing Authority, 32 Liberty Street, Newton, New Jersey on or before May 25th, 2022, by 10:00 AM. The Housing Authority reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received for these services. It also reserves the right to terminate the vendor, for convenience, at any time during the term of the contract. The Authority may choose to utilize the New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program, at any time during the contract, if their prices are lower than the selected vendor.
